Bread Drop PB&J Sandwiches are donated weekly to feed the hungry. Local groups of people from various churches join forces to help with this on-going project.

Caring for Friends is one of the largest food banks and most comprehensive senior/shut-ins meals delivery programs in the 5-county Greater Philadelphia region. Donated meals and/or soups and chili get distributed by CFF volunteers.

Compassion International: The Children's Sunday School currently sponsors a child monthly, who lives in Uganda. Compassion International exists as a Christian child advocacy ministry that releases children from spiritual, economic, social and physical poverty and enables them to become responsible, fulfilled Christian adults.

Family Promise (Interfaith) mission is to help homeless and low-income families achieve sustainable independence through a community faith-based response. JUMC regularly hosts families.

Jesus Victory Garden: The garden volunteer team grows wholesome produce that 100% goes to local food pantries.

Laurel House and Laurels Loft: JUMC supports the faithful volunteers to help provide for the needs of the women and children at Laurel House by collecting specified donations throughout the year.

Living Hope High School and Orphanage in Kenya: Living Hope is an accredited residential Christian school that has been in existence since 2010 in Bungoma, Kenya. Through a dedicated JUMC volunteer, JUMC helps their vision and goals become a reality.

Living Streams Ranch: Opens their hearts and the ranch to children and women so they might find hope and healing through equine related activities in God's creation, Bible Study and healing prayer. JUMC supports the "ranchers" with prayer and donations.

Methodist Services - Angel Tree: Christmas gifts are collected and distributed through Methodist Services programs.

North Hills Food Cupboard: JUMC volunteers staff the food cupboard which services the Glenside area as a satellite of the Mattie Dixon Food Cupboard.

OHAAT/Sew-Haat "Beds for Kids" OHAAT strives to end child bedlessness in the Greater Philadelphia region. Sew-Haat volunteers make pillowcases and no-sew blankets. JUMC collects needed donations throughout the year and volunteer to help distribute items to the families.

Operation Christmas Child: During the month of October, OCC boxes are filled and sent to children around the world who would otherwise not receive any Christmas gifts.



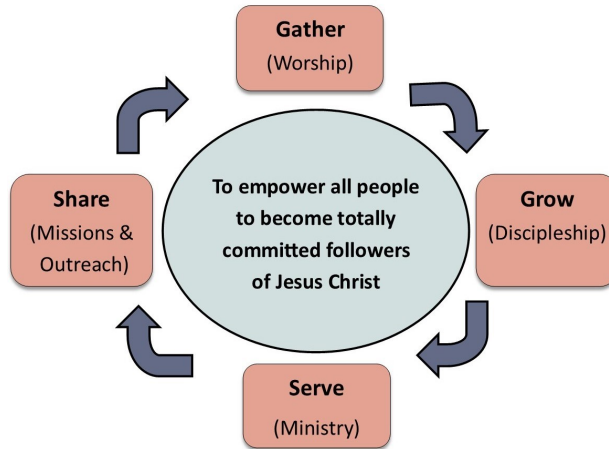
